


- located on the same street where Babeş-Bolyai University of Cluj-Napoca (UBB) is located today

## The University during the communist period

1948 established two universities in Cluj:

- “Victor Babeş” University of Cluj
  - successor of “King Ferdinand I” University
  - teaching in Romanian
- “Bolyai” University of Cluj
  - teaching in Hungarian

1959 - the two universities were merged together as the “Babeş-Bolyai” State University of Cluj

## 1989 Revolution “BABEȘ-BOLYAI” UNIVERSITY OF CLUJ-NAPOCA

- 1989 the name of the university became “BABEȘ-BOLYAI” UNIVERSITY OF CLUJ-NAPOCA
- 2002 it was recognized as the rightful successor of “King Ferdinand I” University
